

T-255 Parents and Scouts:

Last night the Scouts who were eligible and desiring to go to Sea Base in 2005 met, were very focused and productive, and made several decisions.

First, as a reminder, Sea Base requires entry into a lottery to be held between January 15 and February 15, 2004. If picked in the lottery during late February, an immediate charge of \$100 per person is made, non refundable but balance transferable.

Therefore, it is important that parents for Scouts willing to attend confirm that, if Troop 255 wins the lottery, parents will reimburse the Troop for the mandatory \$100 per person deposit, payable at the end of February 2004. Please send the confirmation by return e-mail.
