Merit Badge Advancement Day**

- **There is a \$10 (ten) application fee for the MB Day.**
- **Make the check to “Boy Scouts” and include it with the application.**
- **Morning classes begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at 12:00 noon.**
- **Afternoon classes begin promptly at 1:00 p.m. and conclude at 5:00 p.m.**
- **All Scouts must wear their Class “A” Uniform.**
- **Remember there will be hundreds of Scouts checking in and locating Merit Badge class rooms. Please make plans to arrive at the facility early. Late arrivals may not be allowed to disrupt the class after it starts.**
- **Last year, every class seat was filled-up. Classes will fill-up fast, register as soon as possible to ensure Merit Badge preference.**
- **No refund of the application fee after a Scout has been assigned a class.**
- **There will be no on-site registration for the Advancement Day. No walk-ins.**
- **All registrations must be received by January 31, 2005.**
- **A pizza lunch is provided to all participants.**
- **Because of high demand, a Scout can ONLY register for one Eagle required Merit Badge class. (Some Eagle MB classes may require an “age & rank” selection criteria)**
- **Once you have been notified (telephone call or e-mail) that your Merit Badge application has been accepted you must:**
 - **Get a signed blue card from your Scoutmaster and bring it with you;**
 - **Get the Merit Badge advancement book and bring it with you;**
 - **Read the advancement book;**
 - **Certain classes will require some advance work. Read the pre-requisites carefully.**
