- (2) Keep popcorn machine running and hand out popcorn. A CCHS volunteer also will be available.
- (3) Trolley ride. Accept riders' tokens as they board the trolley. Rides start every half hour.
- (4) Lemonade stand. Dispense free lemonade from a container with a spigot. Keep table neat, plastic cups organized.
- (5) Games and amusements. Blowing bubbles, sidewalk chalk drawing and hopscotch.

This is also a great event for Scouts who are working on their Citizenship of the Community MB.
