T-255 Annual Swim at the MAC

What: T-255 invites P-255 to our annual swim at the Montgomery Aquatics Center. Besides meeting T-255 Scouts and parents, it is time for swim checks and fun in the recreational pool. Who needs swim checks? (1) any Scout and qualified Cub Scout not classified as a Swimmer and wants to attend T-255's May 2007 White Water Camp Out. (2) New Scouts and qualified Cub Scouts who need to satisfy the 2nd class requirements:

7. a. Tell what precautions must be taken for a safe swim.
7. b. Demonstrate your ability to jump feet first into water over your head in depth, level off and swim 25 feet on the surface, stop, turn sharply, resume swimming, then return to your starting place.

And/or the 1st Class Requirement:

9.b. Successfully complete the BSA swimmer test.

Jump feet first into water over your in depth. Swim 75 yards in a strong manner using one or more of the following strokes: sidestroke, breaststroke, trudgen, or crawl swim 25 yards using an easy, resting backstroke. The 100 yards must be swum continuously and include at least one sharp turn. After completing the swim, rest by floating."

Who: All Boy Scouts and parents. Cub Scouts and siblings accompanied by an adult are welcome on this trip.
