SHAKEDOWN EQUIPMENT PROVIDED BY CREW

(This list a composite of the T-255 Common Gear List and the list reproduced from the Philmont Guidebook to Adventure)

Necessary items of equipment for each crew of 7-12 persons to bring to Philmont or to purchase include these (from page 16-17 in Guidebook to Adventure) :

Tent Gear	Metal tent pins, 10 per person *	
	Waterproof ground cloth, 5'6"x7'6", 1 per tent*	
Repair	1 sewing kit with heavy thread and needle	
	Duct tape (BB) *	
	1 multi-type tool	
Hydration	Water bladder	
	2 or 3 water purifiers/filters (recommended)*	
Cooking/Eating	2 or 3 backpacking stoves.* To be mailed to Philmont.	
	Fuel – 4 16oz fuel bottles and funnel.* Purchase in New Mexico possibly at Philmont.	
	4 Fuel bottles, 16oz. To be mailed to Philmont.	
	Bowls for meals	
	Extra 4 quart pot (other pots issued by Philmont, see table below)	
	1-2 Cup(s), measuring type.	
	Cooking mitts (glove could also work)	
	Fire Starters	
	Spices for cooking (optional, salt & pepper issued by Philmont) (BB)	
Cordage & Related	2 x 50' ¼"braided rope. Philmont rope is issued (see list below) but may be worn out.	
	4 strong, larger-size carabiners	
Sanitation	Latrine Kit (shovel, toilet paper, hand sanitizer)	
	Extra toilet paper – 2 rolls. (Philmont also issues toilet paper.)	
Miscellaneous	T-255 Flag ?	
	Crew First Aid kit (see below) (BB)	
	Padlock for your crew locker (extra security)	
	Philmont sectional maps* Jeremys Run map(s)	
	Sunscreen (BB).* –Purchase in New Mexico if needed.	
	Insect repellent not aerosol (BB).* Purchase in New Mexico.	
	Small container of clothes detergent. –Purchase in New Mexico.

BB – Packed in plastic bag to be placed in bear bag at night.
